In her works and interventions, Farzane Vaziritabar addresses the situation of women in Iran and thus also comments on current political conflicts: "It was women who, with the headscarf as a symbol, started one of the strongest protest movements against the regime in Iran for many years." Vaziritabar's work tells the story of the obligation to cover the female head in a focused and visually powerful way, while also involving the audience.

Vaziritabar's work not only encompasses a wide range of media including sculpture, installation, photography, video and performance, but also drawings that explore narratives, identity, place and space.

Farzane Vaziritabar (\*1987 in Yazd, Iran, based in Karlsruhe, Germany) received her diploma in painting from the School of Fine Arts, her bachelor's degree in sculpture and her master's degree in art studies from Tehran University. From 2018, she studied in the international master's programme "Art in Public Space and New Artistic Strategies" at Bauhaus University Weimar, graduating with a master's degree in 2021.

Her works and interventions have been shown in solo and group exhibitions worldwide, including the Kunstmuseum Wolfsburg, Sprengel Museum Hannover and ZKM Karlsruhe.
